TIPS

Snap Modes

There are 3 main snap modes (Snap, X&Y, Polar) used when drawing/modifying. Select this

snap button  and as the cursor is moved around the drawing a symbol is displayed to denote the snap point found e.g. end, mid, centre, grid, intersection etc. The shortcut key is F7.

When the XY button  is selected the next position is identified using X and Y co-ordinates relative to the current position. This can be either via the X & Y input boxes on the system toolbar or by using the dynamic dimensions. The shortcut key is F8 (toggles with 'Polar').

When the polar button  is selected the next position is identified using polar co-ordinates (angle and distance) relative to the current position. This can be either via the 'Distance' & 'Angle' input boxes on the system toolbar or by using the dynamic dimensions. The shortcut key is F8 (toggles with 'XY').

Relative Input

Specify co-ordinate positions relative to existing geometry rather than the last point. Position the cursor over any point (end, mid etc) and hit 'R'. A new position relative to the one selected can be defined.

Force Snaps

When drawing in 'snap' mode you can use the 'E', 'M', 'P' & 'T' keys to force End, Middle, Perpendicular and Tangent points/positions.

Dimension Settings

Parameters that control the appearance of a dimension, text height, arrow size etc. are displayed in the properties toolbar (immediately above the drawing area) as you create or edit a dimension.
